2016 Chilli Cook RULES and Application Official Rules

- 1)....Entry fee is \$25 for EACH Entry. A booth must be rented for EACH Entry... EXAMPLE: If a team wants to enter 2 (two) different chili entries, they will have 2 (two) booths, with total booth fees of \$50.
- 2)....This application MUST be filled out in full, and full booth fees MUST be submitted, or be disqualified.
- 3)....DEADLINE to submit Application is Midnight, Wednesday, July 20th via Po Box 1202, Laytonville, CA.
- 4)....Booth space is 10' x 10'. You may bring a canopy no larger than 10' x 10'
- 5)....Gates open for booth set up is 9:00 AM, Vehicles must be out of the event area by 11:15 AM...
- 6)....Preparing ahead of time is OK. Safe food handling practices must be adhered to. Cooked chili IS subject to testing for safe temperature (140° minimum). Inspection refusal grounds for disqualification
- 7)....Chili Cooks MUST supply a minimum of 5 (five) gallon of chili per entry (more is better)
- 8)....ENTRY TURN IN TIME FOR JUDGING IS 11:30 AM sharp, at the designated chili turn in table
- 9)....Each ENTRY for judging will be submitted in an unmarked sample container provided by the event
- 10)...Contestants will serve up samples to the public for the People's Choice Award in provided containers
- 11)...Contestants will have team NAME and NUMBER on a sheet given them clearly displayed at the booth
- 12)...People's Choice ballots will be given to the public, and tallied at 3:00 PM.
- 13)...LOAD OUT TIME: at the END OF THE EVENT At Dusk No Exceptions No vehicles permitted in the event area until dusk. Cooks must take all their garbage with you, and leave your booth area CLEAN.
- 14)...Cooks and their entire teams agree to be photographed. Photo's may be published online or in paper
- 15)...Awards will be given for Judges 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners, and the Peoples Choice Award
- 16)...Award ceremonies will be at 3:30 PM
- 17)...Cooking to be done with portable propane stove. No open fires. No electricity provided or available
- 18)...All cooks & team members agree Event Producers are not responsible for any injury, loss, or theft
- 19)...This is an Open Class event: No distinctions between beans, no beans, veggie, etc. DO YOUR BEST
